- III. Public comment on union or management proposals or counterproposals

State employee unions or State management may present initial proposals at any publicly noticed meeting. Parties presenting proposals must arrive no later than the scheduled start of the meeting, and have in their possession at least 25 copies of their proposals to distribute to interested members of the public.

If further public meetings are needed to present additional initial proposals, CalHR will announce the dates in another public notice.

Copies of the proposals and counterproposals from these public meetings will be available at the CalHR website (www.calhr.ca.gov) within one day. If no proposals or counterproposals are presented, the CalHR website will indicate that no initial bargaining proposals were presented or received.
