<b>SIS</b>	Granting or denying Special Ingrade Salary Adjustment
<b>PUN</b>	Adverse Action
<b>715</b>	Identifies whether or not a pay period is qualifying

<b>C</b>	<b>Correct.</b> Any transaction code followed by the letter C has been corrected. These corrections are not typically punitive.
<b>V</b>	<b>Void.</b> Any transaction code followed by the letter V has been voided is not a part of the employment history
<b>E</b>	<b>Expunged.</b> Any transaction code followed by the letter E has been expunged and is no longer part of the employment history.
