D	Employees are eligible for Rate 4 based on Criteria D identified in the Agreement between the Department of Personnel Administration and the California Energy Commission.
E	Employees are eligible for Rate 5 based on Criteria E identified in the Agreement between the Department of Personnel Administration and the California Energy Commission.
F	Employees are eligible for Rate 6 based on Criteria F identified in the Agreement between the Department of Personnel Administration and the California Energy Commission.

CRITERIA - Continued	
G	Employees are eligible for Rate 7 based on Criteria G identified in the Agreement between the Department of Personnel Administration and the California Energy Commission.
H	Employees are eligible for Rate 8 based on Criteria H identified in the Agreement between the Department of Personnel Administration and the California Energy Commission.
I	Employees are eligible for Rate 9 based on Criteria I identified in the Agreement between the Department of Personnel Administration and the California Energy Commission.
J	Employees are eligible for Rate 10 based on Criteria J identified in the Agreement between the Department of Personnel Administration and the California Energy Commission.
