Re: Addenda for Bargaining Units (BU) 2 – California Attorneys, Administrative Law Judges and Hearing Officers in State Employment (CASE), Bargaining Unit 9 – Professional Engineers in California Government (PECG) and Bargaining Unit 10 – California Association of Professional Scientists (CAPS)

Addenda to Memoranda of Understanding: Realignment

This notification is respectfully submitted to advise you that as part of the historic realignment of California's state corrections functions, the Department of Personnel Administration and the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) recently reached agreement on an alternative layoff process for employees with CASE (representing state Bargaining Unit 2), PECG (representing state Bargaining Unit 9), and CAPS (representing state Bargaining Unit 10). These agreements are substantially similar to the realignment addenda that DPA submitted to the JLBC on October 11, 2011. The JLBC subsequently approved those addenda, without requiring further legislative action, on October 20, 2011.

Like the other realignment agreements, BUs 2, 9, and 10's agreements are addenda to the Bargaining Units' current memoranda of understanding (MOU). The addenda are effective until the state's prison realignment program is completed.

The attached addenda will become effective upon review and determination by the Joint Legislative Budget Committee (JLBC) that these agreements reduce costs, are within the original framework of the MOUs, and that no further legislative action is needed. To achieve the savings associated with these agreements in a timely fashion, we respectfully request an expedited review of these agreements by the JLBC.
