Dear Mr. Gillihan:

On June 8, 2015, the Department of Human Resources submitted to the Legislature addenda to the memoranda of understanding (MOUs) between the state and three bargaining units. The Joint Legislative Budget Committee determines if MOU addenda agreed to by the administration in fiscal year 2014-15 require legislative approval. The employees affected by the agreements now before the committee are represented by:

- **Unit 6.** Correctional officers and parole agents represented by the California Correctional Peace Officers Association (CCPOA). Affected employees work for the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR).
- **Unit 7.** State peace officers and other law enforcement officials represented by the California Statewide Law Enforcement Association (CSLEA). Affected employees are Hospital Police Officers at Patton State Hospital.
- **Unit 19.** Health and social services professionals represented by the American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees (AFSCME). Affected employees are Clinical Social Workers who work for CDCR.

*Administration May Implement Agreements.* Under state law, the Legislature must approve any provision of an MOU or similar agreement that requires the expenditure of funds. These agreements do not require the expenditure of funds not already approved by the Legislature. Accordingly, the administration may implement these agreements with CCPOA, CSLEA, and AFSCME immediately without the need for additional legislative action.
