CALIFORNIA CITY CORRECTIONAL FACILITY


This agreement represents the full and complete understanding of the parties at the conclusion of the negotiations regarding the Implementation of a Re-Entry Hub at the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation's California City Correctional Facility (CDCR Log#15-108-0) completed on October 22, 2015. This agreement becomes an addendum to the Agreement Between the State of California and the California Correctional Peace Officers Association, Memorandum of Understanding, Article 27, Section 27.01, which expires on July 2, 2015.

1. California City Correctional Facility (CAC) Management and CCPOA agree that when a PSA requests accommodation/overtime for purposes of the Re-Entry Hub/CalID program related work, the supervisor/manager shall determine the appropriate measure necessary to accomplish the completion of said work, and such requests shall not be denied if a need exists.
2. CCPOA and CAC Management agree to reopen this meet and confer table, at the request of either party, within 90 days, to address any unforeseen impact issues that cannot first be resolved locally.


