NOTICE OF REVISION TO THE PRISONERS OVERCOMING OBSTACLES AND
CREATING HOPE (POOCH) PROGRAM AT THE RICHARD J DONOVAN
CORRECTIONAL FACILITY (CDCR LOG #15-115-0)


This Agreement represents the full and complete understanding reached by and between the parties at the conclusion of Meet and Confer negotiations on November 5, 2015, regarding the Notice of Revision to the Prisoners Overcoming Obstacles and Creating Hope (POOCH) Program at the Richard J. Donovan Correctional Facility (CDCR Log No. 15-115-0). This Agreement becomes an addendum to the current State Bargaining Unit 6 Memorandum of Understanding, Article XXVII, and Section 27.01, which expires on July 2, 2015.

1. RJDCF Management and CCPOA agree to meet and discuss locally within 120 days after the placement of dog in Facility "D" Housing Unit #20, to evaluate the progress of the POOCH Program and to consider relocation of the program to another Housing Unit.
2. CCPOA and RJD Management agree the maximum number of POOCH dogs to be six (6) in Housing Unit #20 on Facility D.
3. CCPOA and RJD Management agree the placards for identifying POOCH designated cells will be posted by the POOCH Coordinator, or designee, using existing funds.
4. RJD Management has designated Housing Unit #20 on Facility D for the POOCH program. Management agrees that they will make every attempt to cluster the POOCH participants within said Housing Unit.
5. Absent an emergency, BU#6 Uniformed Custody Staff members shall not be tasked with additional workload in association with the POOCH Program.
6. RJD Management agrees to provide an overview of RJDCF's POOCH Program to Facility D BU#6 Staff, prior to implementation.
7. CCPOA and RJD Management agree the Local CCPOA Chapter President or designee shall be notified of all aggressive dog bites by POOCH Program dogs.
8. CCPOA and RJD Management agree to reopen this meet and confer table at the request of either party, within sixty (60) days of receipt of first dog, to address any unforeseen impact issues that cannot first be resolved locally.


