
This Agreement represents the full and complete understanding reached by and between the parties at the conclusion of Meet and Confer negotiations on December 28, 2015 regarding the implementation of the Canine Companion for Independence/Puppy program (CCI) at CHCF. This Agreement shall become an addendum to the current Bargaining Unit Six (BU6) Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) which expires on July 2, 2015.

- If the "CCI" puppy program expands beyond "E" Facility Dorms 2 through 5, CCPOA will be Notified in accordance with the BU6 MOU.
- Management will provide a program overview/summary memo that will be placed in the dorms where dogs are housed.
- Either party may reopen this table, within 120 days of this agreement, to address unforeseen impact issues that cannot be resolved locally.
- A non-permanent identification tag (i.e. index card) matching the dog's identification will be placed on the dog's primary assigned crate.
- The parties agree that the local CHCF CCPOA Chapter President (or designee) shall be notified of all dog bites.
- Parties agree that unless there is an emergency, BU6 staff shall not be tasked with additional workload in association with the CHCF Canine Companion for Independence/Puppy program, other than the duties currently established.


