

**AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE
CALIFORNIA CORRECTIONAL PEACE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION AND THE
STATE OF CALIFORNIA,
DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND REHABILITATION REGARDING THE
NOTICE OF CONVERSION OF CENTINELA STATE PRISON'S
FACILITY B LEVEL III GENERAL POPULATION YARD TO LEVEL IV 270 DESIGN
GENERAL POPULATION YARD (CDCR LOG #15-102-0)**

This Agreement represents the full and complete understanding reached by and between the parties at the conclusion of Meet and Confer negotiations held on October 13, 2015 and January 20, 2016, regarding the Conversion of Centinela State Prison's Facility B Level III General Population Yard to Level IV 270 Design General Population Yard. This Agreement becomes an addendum to the current State Bargaining Unit 6 Memorandum of Understanding, Article 27, Section 27.01, which expired on July 2, 2015.

1. CEN and CCPOA agree morning and afternoon yard/dayroom shall consist of one tier choosing dayroom or yard. At the scheduled inline, those participating in yard may return back into the building (no outline).
2. CEN and CCPOA agree to a gradual night dayroom program. For the first 45 days after implementation, night dayroom shall consist of one half tiers (i.e. cells 101-125) of A1A assigned workers.
3. CEN and CCPOA agree that the B Facility Yard #1 Correctional Officer on second and third watch shall be issued a MK 46 CO Canister during yard and feeding, as needed.
4. CEN and CCPOA agree that during meal release there shall be no more than two housing units out at one time. Movement will flow with no cross traffic.
5. CEN and CCPOA agree yard recall shall start at 1115 and 1615 hours, two buildings at a time.
6. CEN and CCPOA agree that meal release shall be conducted by releasing no more than one section of one tier at a time (i.e. A- section lower cells 101-117, etc.).
7. CEN and CCPOA agree to meet locally regarding changes to post orders within 30 days of the implementation.
8. CEN and CCPOA agree during second and third watch feeding, B-Facility SP #3 and A-Facility SP #3, shall be assigned to dining room gun responsibilities.
