

AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
THE CALIFORNIA CORRECTIONAL PEACE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION AND THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA,  
CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND REHABILITATION CALIFORNIA SUBSTANCE ABUSE  
TREATMENT FACILITY AND STATE PRISON AT CORCORAN, REGARDING CONVERSION OF LEVEL II GP TO  
LEVEL II SNY AND LEVEL II EOP TO LEVEL II EOP-SNY  
(CDCR LOG # 15-160-0/CCPOA NG #27187)

This Agreement represents the full and complete understanding reached by and between the parties at the conclusion of the Meet and Confer negotiations on March 16, 2016, regarding the Conversion of Level II GP to Level II SNY and Level II EOP to Level II EOP-SNY. This agreement becomes an addendum to the current State Bargaining Unit 06 Memorandum of Understanding, Article 27, Section 27.1, which expires on July 2, 2015.

- CCPOA and SATF Management agree that Facility F EOP population will be housed in Facility F-3 B & C sections only. In the event there is EOP overflow, the overflow population shall only be housed in F-3.
- CCPOA and SATF Management agree at no time shall SNY and GP population be housed in the same section in any Facility F housing unit.
- CCPOA and SATF Management agree to designate Facility F Building 3 as the first housing unit to receive Re-entry HUB/EOP/SNY Level II population. Upon completion of F Building 3, we will then proceed to fill F Building 2, and then followed by F Building 1.
- CCPOA and SATF Management agree that once any housing unit has Level 2 GP and Level 2 SNY in the same housing unit, only one section door will be opened and closed at any time until GP population are no longer housed on Facility F.
- CCPOA and SATF Management agree that once any housing unit has Level 2 GP and Level 2 SNY housed in the same housing unit, each section door shall be labeled by utilizing existing resources, "GP" or "SNY" to assist staff with identifying each section.
- CCPOA and SATF Management agree that GP will prepare food trays for cell feeding all SNY in their respective housing unit on Facility F. This process will continue until the SNY population is more than half. At that point, SNY population will acquire dining duties and GP will be cell fed in their respective housing unit.
- CCPOA and SATF Management agree that the Facility F Dining workers will deliver diabetic snacks to the perspective housing units by the daily list generated and provided by Medical staff prior to feeding the population.
- CCPOA and SATF Management agree Facility F is designated as a Level II SNY/EOP and may include SAP and Re-entry programs. If new programs are implemented, CCPOA will be notified consistent with 27.01 of the MOU.
- CCPOA and SATF Management agree Facility F KOP medications will be distributed to the populations during second watch hours except for emergencies or any unforeseen reasons that will be documented to the designated Facility Captain.
- CCPOA and SATF Management agree that two separate Medical Ducat Tracking lists that identifies appointments for SNY and GP population will be created. This is a temporary process which will continue until the last GP population departs from Facility F.
