CALIFORNIA CORRECTIONAL PEACE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION REGARDING THE

CHANGE TO ADMINISTRATIVE SEGREGATION UNIT (ASU) ESCORTING PROCEDURES AT FOLSOM
STATE PRISON (FSP)

This agreement represents the full and complete understanding reached by and between the CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND REHABILITATION (CDCR) and THE CALIFORNIA CORRECTIONAL PEACE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION (CCPOA), on April 21, 2016. This agreement becomes an addendum to the current Bargaining Unit Six Memorandum of Understanding, Section 27.01 which expires on July 2, 2015.

Therefore:

1. The parties agree that ASU population considered to be staff assaultive within the ASU will be escorted by two Correctional Officers, until the review by the ASU Institutional Classification Committee to determine the escorting ratio.
2. Parties agree that upon request on or before June 20, 2016, this table may be re-open for unresolved, unforeseen, or newly discovered impact issues that cannot be resolved locally pertaining to this notice and agreement.
