

THE FOLLOWING CONSTITUTES AN AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND REHABILITATION AND THE
CALIFORNIA CORRECTIONAL PEACE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION REGARDING THE
SVSP DOG TRAINING PROGRAM

This agreement represents the full and complete understanding reached by and between the CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND REHABILITATION (CDCR) and the California Correctional Peace Officers Association (CCPOA), on July 06, 2016. This agreement becomes an addendum to the current Bargaining Unit Six Memorandum of Understanding, Section 27.01 which expires on July 2, 2018.

WHEREAS, CDCR and CCPOA have arrived at the following agreement, which is mutually prepared by the parties;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:


1. The parties agree that SVSP will provide placards for identification purposes for cells that house the dogs.
2. The parties agree that absent an emergency, Bargaining Unit (BU) 6 will not be required or responsible to escort, or control dogs in the Dog Training Program.
3. Parties agree that either party may reopen this table 90 days from implementation, if newly discovered or unresolved impact issues are identified.
4. The parties agree that the local CCPOA Chapter President shall be notified of all reported dog bites of BU 6 staff.
5. The parties agree that SVSP will provide all participants in the Dog Training Program a SVSP Dog Program I.D. card to be carried while training their dog.
6. The parties agree that all dogs in the Dog Training Program will wear I.D. tags provided to them by the program provider.
7. The parties agree that BU 6 Officers are not responsible for the upkeep and care of the Dog Training Program Dog's housed in their buildings.
8. The parties agree that SVSP has the right to move or expand the Dog Training Program to other facilities at SVSP. If there is unforeseen impact due to the movement or expansion that cannot be resolved locally, the parties agree to reopen this table.
9. The parties agree that dog kennels will only be in the cells upon evening lock up until the beginning of 2nd watch programming, during modified program, or when needed to meet training requirements. All other times the kennels will be stored in their designated area.

10. The parties agree that no BU 6 staff will be required to decontaminate a dog in the Dog Training Program when exposed to chemical agents, but they shall afford the participant the opportunity to do so.
11. The parties agree that SVSP management will provide cleaning supplies to maintain sanitary conditions where the dog program is located.
12. Parties agree that the Dog Training Program on D facility, 2 yard at SVSP, will not exceed more than twenty (20) dogs, without a local discussion and agreement between the CCPOA Local Chapter and SVSP Management.
13. Parties agree that dogs participating in the Dog Training Program, will not be allowed into the Mental Health Building and Mental Health Annex.
14. Parties agree that once the dog population within the Dog Training Program reaches 15, CCPOA Local Chapter and SVSP Management will meet and discuss over additional impact issues.






