

LOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE
CALIFORNIA CORRECTIONAL PEACE OFFICERS' ASSOCIATION
AND
THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA,
DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND REHABILITATION (CDCR),
MULE CREEK STATE PRISON,
ALTERNATIVE HOUSING (AU) BEDS (FACILITY C, BUILDING 13)

This Agreement represents the full and complete understanding reached by and between the parties at the conclusion of the Meet and Confer negotiations on July 14, 2016, regarding the Alternative Housing (AH), Facility C, Building 13. This Agreement becomes an addendum to the current State Bargaining Unit 6 Memorandum of Understanding, Article 27, Section 27.01, which expires on July 2, 2018.


1. MCSP and CCPOA agree to place identification placards in housing units on cell doors when an inmate is rehoused in AH, using existing material/resources.
2. MCSP and CCPOA agree all AH post orders will be updated and correct within 30 days.
3. MCSP and CCPOA agree Building 13 GP AH escorts off the facility to TTA/CTC will be conducted by HCA custody staff. Building 13 GP AH escorts within FAC C will be conducted by FAC C Security Patrols.
4. MCSP and CCPOA agree to meet and discuss locally any identified impact issues in regards to alternative housing notice. In the event, unresolved issues remain, or if unforeseen impact issues are identified, that impact BU 6, CCPOA may request to reopen this table within ninety (90) days and the parties will reconvene.

This Agreement may be signed by facsimile and in parts, which when all necessary signatures are obtained, shall have the same force and effect as though all signatures were executed on one document.
