

**Agreement Between the  
California Correctional Peace Officers Association (CCPOA),  
California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation,  
California State Prison - Sacramento (CSP-SAC)**

**This Agreement represents the full and complete understanding reached by and between the parties at the conclusion of the Meet and Confer negotiations on July 15, 2016, regarding the Conversion of Facility B, Building 8, section C from Psychiatric Services Unit (PSU) to Psychiatric Services Transition Program (PSTP) (CDCR Log #16-057-0). This agreement becomes an addendum to the current Bargaining Unit 06 Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) Article 27.01 which expires July 2, 2018.**

- During the Psychiatric Services Transition Program (PSTP) yard, the PSTP Officer's primary responsibility is the direct and constant observation of the yard program.
- The parties agree that Facility B8 Control Booth Officers may not be able to maintain direct and constant supervision of PSTP programs being conducted in section C, while performing other duties or responsibilities associated with the Control Booth position.
- Prior to implementation of the day room schedule for Facility B8, section C, CSP-SAC Management will meet with the local CSP-SAC CCPOA Chapter to discuss safety and security concerns.
- The parties agree that either party may re-open this table within 90 days of active day room program to address any unforeseen workload impact issues, including any issues that pertain to Facility B8, section C being utilized to house non-PSTP.


