(CDCR LOG # 16-104-0)


This Agreement represents the full and complete understanding reached by and between the parties at the conclusion of the Meet and Confer negotiations on July 18, 2016, regarding the Inmate Escort Policy change. This agreement becomes an addendum to the current State Bargaining Unit 06 Memorandum of Understanding, Article 27, Section 27.01, which expires on July 2, 2018.

1. CSP-COR and CCPOA agree that utilizing existing resources, training will be provided to all BU6 staff regarding the change in the escorting process and escorting ratios. A list of BU6 staff who have received training will be provided to CCPOA no later than 90 days from the date of this agreement.
2. CSP-COR and CCPOA agree either party may reopen this table within 90 days to address any unforeseen workload impact issues that cannot be resolved locally.




