REGARDING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF OPERATIONAL PROCEDURE 216,  
HOUSING ASSIGNMENT CHANGE REQUEST (BED MOVE REQUEST)  
(CDCR LOG # 16-149-0)

This Agreement represents the full and complete understanding reached by and between the parties at the conclusion of the Meet and Confer negotiations on August 25, 2016, regarding the Implementation of Operational Procedure 216, Housing Assignment Change Request at CIW. This agreement becomes an addendum to the current State Bargaining Unit 06 Memorandum of Understanding, Article 27, Section 27.1, which expires on July 2, 2018.

1. CCPOA and CIW agree the revised policy regarding the Housing Assignment Change Requests shall be provided to local CCPOA representatives prior to final signature or implementation.
2. CCPOA and CIW agree training shall be provided prior to implementation. It is further agreed, training shall be in a training environment and proof of practice shall be provided to local CCPOA representatives.
3. CCPOA and CIW agree to reopen negotiations within 90 days of implementation addressing any unforeseen impact issues not previously discussed, that cannot be resolved locally first.




