


AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
THE CALIFORNIA STATE PRISON – CORCORAN (CSP-COR)  
AND THE CALIFORNIA CORRECTIONAL PEACE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION (CCPOA)  
REGARDING THE DEACTIVATION OF BUILDINGS A AND B IN MINIMUM SUPPORT FACILITY AT  
CALIFORNIA STATE PRISON - CORCORAN  
(CDCR LOG # 16-160-0)

This Agreement represents the full and complete understanding reached by and between the parties at the conclusion of the Meet and Confer negotiations on October 13, 2016 regarding the deactivation of buildings A and B in Minimum Support Facility (MSF) at CSP-COR. This agreement becomes an addendum to the current State Bargaining Unit 06 Memorandum of Understanding, Article 27, Section 27.01, which expires on July 2, 2018.

1. The State and CCPOA agree that normally, visiting officers will escort Minimum Support Facility (MSF) to the Level 3 entrance, Level 4 entrance and the Administrative Building.
2. The State and CCPOA agree that all BU6 members will receive updated training related to alarm/emergency response to MSF. The training will not result in overtime costs.
3. The State and CCPOA agree to assign a set of response keys to complex control for emergency response to MSF.
4. CCPOA and CSP-Corcoran Management agree to re-open this table at the request of either party within 90 days to address any unforeseen impact issues that cannot be resolved locally.






