


AGREEMENT BETWEEN
CALIFORNIA CORRECTIONAL PEACE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION (CCPOA),
AND
CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND REHABILITATION (CDCR),
CALIFORNIA STATE PRISON – SACRAMENTO (SAC)
REGARDING THE INVESTIGATIVE SERVICES UNIT'S (ISU) USE OF
CELL PHONE DETECTION EQUIPMENT
CDCR LOG NO.16-133-0

This agreement represents the full and complete understanding reached by and between the California Correctional Peace Officers Association (CCPOA), and California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) on October 28, 2016. This agreement becomes an addendum to the current Bargaining Unit (BU) 6 Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), Section 27.01 which expires on July 2, 2018.

WHEREAS, CDCR and CCPOA have arrived at the following agreement, which is mutually prepared by the parties the parties agree as follows:

- The Manta Ray, Wolf Hound Pro, or Pocket Hound cell phone detection equipment will not be intentionally utilized on BU 6 Staff.
- If a personal cell phone is unintentionally discovered on a BU 6 staff member through use of the Manta Ray, Pocket Hound, or Wolf Hound Pro, and determined to be confiscated, the personal cell phone will be placed into a collection bag/envelope in front of the BU 6 staff member and stored in the Watch Commanders office. The BU 6 staff member shall be afforded the opportunity to lock their cell phone prior to relinquishing it to the ISU Supervisor.
- If any ISU Officer discovers a personal cell phone on a BU 6 staff, any ISU Supervisor will be notified.
- The Manta Ray, Pocket Hound, and Wolf Hound Pro will only be utilized by ISU custody staff.


