

ADDENDUM TO STATEWIDE AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE CALIFORNIA CORRECTIONAL PEACE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION (CCPOA)
AND
THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND REHABILITATION (CDCR)
REGARDING THE YOUTHFUL OFFENDER PROGRAM (YOP)


This Agreement represents the full and complete understanding reached by and between the parties at the conclusion of the Meet and Confer negotiations conducted on November 1, 2016 regarding the Youthful Offender Program (YOP) designation being expanded to three (3) additional CDCR Adult institutions (Avenal State Prison (ASP), California Correctional Facility (CAC) and Pleasant Valley State Prison (PVSP). It is not the intention of parties to amend, nullify or add to the Kagel decision with this agreement. This Agreement shall become an addendum to the current Bargaining Unit Six (BU6) Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) which expires on July 2, 2018.

- The State agrees to review the feasibility of integrating the CDCR Form 128-B into SOMS.
- The State and CCPOA agree that a list of staff who have received "Youthful Offender Program" training will be identified on request of the CCPOA.
- The State and CCPOA agree that within 90 days of the following criteria being met, either party may request to re-open this table to discuss unforeseen impact. The criteria are:
 - 1) All receiving institutions have at least one (1) YOP.
 - 2) The majority of the receiving institutions have 50 YOP each.
- The State and CCPOA agree that all CCIs in institutions housing YOPs who have YOPs on their caseload will be trained within 60 days.
- The State and CCPOA agree that the AB 1276 trained staff participating in the Institution Classification Committee (ICC) will be identified on the classification chrono.
- CDCR and CCPOA agree that the YOP expansion institutions (ASP, CAC and PVSP) local CCPOA chapter may request, within 180 days, to meet locally regarding any unresolved identified BU 6 impact issues related to YOP placements.
- CDCR and CCPOA agree that upon request, the Correctional Counselor (CCI) at YOP designated institutions will be provided with a list of YOP placements.
- The Notice in this matter identified three additional designated institutions (ASP, CAC, and PVSP). If CDCR implements the YOP program at any additional institutions, not identified in the October 18, 2015 YOP Statewide Agreement, or this Addendum to, CCPOA will be provided notice as required in the BU 6 MOU, Article 27.01.





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

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
