


AGREEMENT BETWEEN

THE CALIFORNIA CORRECTIONAL PEACE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION AND THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND REHABILITATION CALIFORNIA SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT FACILITY AND STATE PRISON AT CORCORAN, REGARDING CONVERSION OF FACILITY E BUILDING 1 AD-SEG TO LEVEL III SENSITIVE NEEDS YARD BEDS (SNY)  
(CDCR LOG # 16-169-0)

This Agreement represents the full and complete understanding reached by and between the parties at the conclusion of the Meet and Confer negotiations on November 16, 2016, regarding the Conversion of Facility E Building 1 Ad-Seg to Level III Sensitive Needs Yard Beds (SNY). This agreement becomes an addendum to the current State Bargaining Unit 06 Memorandum of Understanding, Article 27, Section 27.01, which expires on July 2, 2018.

- CCPOA and SATF Management agree all Facility E yard officers and Security Patrol Officers will be assigned response keys to Building E1 utilizing existing funds, materials, and resources.
- CCPOA and SATF Management agree that the two (2) doors leading to Room #137A and #137B (the former Property Room) from the C Section Day Room will remain locked at all times. No staff will be assigned keys to these doors; the keys will be accessible in the Control Booth, behind glass in the event of an emergency.
- CCPOA and SATF Management agree to incorporate Building E1 into the Alarm Response Plan.
- CCPOA and SATF Management agree Out of Bounds lines will be painted in front of the Dumb Waiter, and the former property room doors located in Building E1 C-Section dayroom utilizing existing funds, materials and resources.
- CCPOA and SATF Management agree the Dumb Waiter in Building E1 A Section will be secured with a locking mechanism utilizing existing funds, materials and resources.
- CCPOA and SATF Management agree Facility E1 BU6 staff will not normally be responsible for providing coverage to the outside walk-alone yard modules when Receiving and Release utilize these modules for population overflow. In the event coverage is not available from Central Services and E1 BU6 staff must be utilized SATF Management shall provide this coverage in accordance with 16.05 of the BU6 MOU.
- CCPOA and SATF Management agree when there are no Transportation Officers available to transport to Corcoran ASU, transports will be conducted in accordance with local operating procedures.
- CCPOA and SATF Management agree that absent an emergency situation, transport of individuals who do not meet STRH housing criteria, will be a scheduled transport to Corcoran State Prison ASU for Ad-Seg placement. The transport will normally be placed on the transportation scheduling sheet for hiring appropriate assigned BU6 Transportation staff coverage.
- CCPOA and SATF Management agree that the capacity of Building E1 is 200 beds. In the event that the conversion exceeds 150 Level III SNY beds, local Management will notify the local CCPOA Chapter President of designee.
- CCPOA and SATF Management agree either party may request to re-open this table within ninety (90) days of activation if newly identified impact issues to BU6 are unable to be resolved locally.




