


AGREEMENT BETWEEN

(CDCR LOG #16-213-0)


This Agreement represents the full and complete understanding reached by and between the parties at the conclusion of the Meet and Confer negotiations on December 7, 2016, regarding the change to Operational Procedure (OP) 317, Daily Movement Schedule at CIW. This agreement becomes an addendum to the current State Bargaining Unit 06 Memorandum of Understanding, Article 27, Section 27.1, which expires on July 2, 2018.

1. CIW and CCPOA agree the Security Patrol Officers assigned to the area shall not normally be reassigned duties during the recreation and circle unlock. Should an unforeseen circumstance occur, CIW shall ensure alternate coverage of the area during the unlock period.
2. CIW agrees to paint out-of-bounds and circle identification lines, within 45 days of the date of implementation, using existing funds, materials and resources.
3. CIW and CCPOA agree the circle area does not include the sidewalks in front of Latham HU, Emmons HU, and the walkway between Harrison HU and Wilson HU.
4. CIW and CCPOA agree to reopen this meet and confer table within 90 days to address any unforeseen impact issues that cannot first be resolved locally.


