


This Agreement represents the full and complete understanding reached by and between the parties at the conclusion of Meet and Confer negotiations on December 13, 2016, regarding the Notice of Changes to Operational Procedure #215, Minimum Support Facility, Sensitive Needs Yard Procedures (CDCR Log No. 16-224-0). This agreement becomes an addendum to the current State Bargaining Unit 06 Memorandum of Understanding, Article 27, Section 27.01, which expires on July 2, 2018.

1. CCPOA and ISP Management agree that first watch BU 6 MSF Staff shall not be tasked with processing mail during dayroom programming hours.
2. CCPOA and ISP Management agree to reopen this Meet and Confer table at the request of either party, within 30 days, to address any unforeseen impact issues that cannot first be resolved locally.






