

**Agreement Between the  
California Correctional Peace Officers Association (CCPOA) and  
California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation,  
California State Prison - Sacramento (CSP-SAC)**

This Agreement represents the full and complete understanding reached by and between the parties at the conclusion of the Meet and Confer negotiations on January 6, 2017, regarding the Escort and Housing Procedures of Mobility Impaired Inmates. (CDCR Log #16-206-0; CCPOA NG# 53297). This agreement becomes an addendum to the current Bargaining Unit 06 Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) Article 27.01 which expires July 2, 2018.


- The State and CCPOA agree when issuing ADA interim accommodation for participants awaiting transfer, the general chrono language will include the use of IDAP workers. If IDAP is unavailable, depending on assessment, one or two Officers shall be utilized to assist the traveling up and down the lower tier dayroom stairs. Based upon safety and security, when assisting participants that may require close contact, the Officer may utilize mechanical restraints if they deem necessary.
- The State and CCPOA agree that if the PSU lift is inoperable staff shall contact the HCA Supervisor who will coordinate with medical to provide consultation for proper removal and traversing of stairs and placement back into wheelchair.




