<b>R06 and S06:</b>	
Employees working four or more hours of a scheduled shift between midnight Friday and midnight Sunday shall receive \$2.50 per hour for their scheduled weekend work. Weekend shift differentials are not to be combined with night shift differential.	\$2.50 = 8WKN

**SECTION 14:****PAY DIFFERENTIALS**

<b>R18 and 18 Excluded classes:</b>	
Employees working a regularly scheduled weekend shift shall receive \$.50 per hour for their scheduled weekend shift starting with the PM shift/3 <sup>rd</sup> watch beginning on Fridays through the NOC shift/1 <sup>st</sup> watch ending on Mondays. Overtime shifts and leave time usage does not qualify for this differential.	\$0.50 = 8WKN
<b>R19:</b>	
Employees working four or more hours of a scheduled shift on either a Saturday or a Sunday shall receive an additional \$1.35 cents per hour for their scheduled weekend shift.	\$1.35 = 8WKN
