# EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The California Department of Human Resources (CalHR) mission is to serve as the trusted advisor to our strategic partners and the public, providing exceptional human resource services and guidance. Our vision at CalHR is shaping California's future of public service excellence with fair employment opportunities and an engaged workforce. We foster an environment where everyone can thrive and contribute their unique talents and experiences.

## PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

Pursuant to Government Code section 19792 (k), and as directed by the Governor's Office, CalHR implemented the Discrimination Complaint Tracking System (DCTS) in 2020. The DCTS is a secure, comprehensive, cloud-based case management system used by state departments to track EEO complaints throughout the investigative process. CalHR provides statewide leadership, coordination, and technical guidance to state departments, which together employ more than 230,000 staff as of December 31, 2024. CalHR monitors DCTS and analyses the data to create the annual report.

From January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024, as required by statute, departments entered EEO complaints of discrimination, harassment, retaliation, and denials of reasonable accommodation into DCTS. Each quarter, EEO Officers are responsible for submitting a Quarterly Report confirming that either all complaints have been entered or that no complaints were received. The report reflects data provided by departments through the Discrimination Complaint Tracking System (DCTS) and is intended to support transparency, accountability, and continuous improvement in EEO practices statewide.

## PROTECTED CATEGORIES

California law safeguards employees from unlawful workplace discrimination based on legally protected categories. These categories encompass identities recognized under state harassment and discrimination statutes. When a department receives a complaint alleging inappropriate work-related conduct, it is on notice and obligated to conduct a thorough review and assess if the complaint violates the agency's EEO policies. California prohibits unlawful discrimination, harassment, and retaliation in employment based on the following protected categories:

## TOTAL CASES

From January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024, departments statewide reported a total of 2,261 internal and external cases received. Of those, 1,484 were accepted for investigation. Cases not accepted for an EEO investigation either were referred to the appropriate division within their department for review or were found to be outside of EEO jurisdictional responsibility. All graphs and tables displayed represent data from 2024 unless otherwise specified. Additionally, internal and external case information will be reported separately unless stated otherwise.

## COMPLAINTS

Departments may receive different types of complaints such as an Internal Complaint, Anonymous Complaint, or Management Inquiry. Internal complaints are complaints that are submitted typically by the complainant directly to the department of the alleged harm. An external complaint is when a complainant submits their complaint to an external agency such as, the California Civil Rights Department (CRD), or Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EEOC). Subsequently the department where the alleged harm occurred is contacted by the external agency and may be required to provide a response regarding the complaint received. Each case entered in the DCTS may contain one or more complaints, with each complaint potentially identifying a different protected category. For this reason, the total number of complaints may be greater than the total number of cases received. Additionally, a complainant may indicate the alleged harm to be connected to more than one protected category.

## INTERNAL COMPLAINTS

Departments received 1,506 complaints with 1,232 accepted for investigation. As of December 31, 2024, 510 cases and 841 complaints were closed. In the following charts are the departments' reported outcomes for those complaints:

## COMPLAINT OUTCOMES

When a department completes an investigation and closes the case, each complaint within the case must be properly documented with an outcome. The possible outcomes are

Unsubstantiated, Substantiated, Withdrawn, or Statute of Limitation Run. In California, a statute of limitation is the period of time a complainant has for seeking legal action when pursuing relief for work discrimination, harassment, denial of reasonable accommodation, or retaliation. For a federal discrimination charge to be timely, the claimant must have filed the charge with the EEOC within 180 calendar days of the date last harmed (extended to 300 days under certain circumstances) or with the CRD within three years of the date last harmed.

Withdrawn complaints are less common, and if they occur, departments must clearly state the reason for withdrawing the complaint within the associated DCTS case file. A complaint may only be reported as withdrawn when:

- The complainant no longer wishes to pursue the complaint, and the department explains why it is not necessary to pursue the complaint as a Management Inquiry.
- The CRD or EEOC requests a response from the department and subsequently decides to no longer pursue the complaint.

## POST INVESTIGATION

When an investigation's findings determine there has been a violation of the department's EEO policies, the complaint should then be classified as Substantiated and departments must take "prompt" and "effective" corrective action. Departments must also document the action taken within the case file in the DCTS by selecting one of the following action types: Corrective, Disciplinary, None, Other, Referral to Law Enforcement, or Referred for Action.

- **Corrective:** Actions taken to improve the employee's performance to an acceptable level or to prevent continued misconduct.
- **Disciplinary:** Legal actions taken in response to an employee's serious or continued failure to meet the rules of conduct as defined by GC 19572. Adverse action is defined in California State Government employment as dismissal, demotion, suspension, or other disciplinary action.
- **None:** May be used when a respondent retired or resigned in lieu of or before disciplinary action, or when the respondent is a vendor or other non-state entity and action cannot be taken by the state. Departments are instructed to add appropriate case file notes, which clearly indicate the reason for reporting the action taken as None.
- **Other:** May be used when none of the other actions apply to the action taken. Departments are instructed to add appropriate case file notes, which clearly indicate the reason for choosing Other.
- **Referral to Law Enforcement:** Result of potential criminal activity.  
**Referred for Action:** Referred to another unit or division (Human Resources, Legal, etc.) for follow-up actions.

## ACTIONS TAKEN BY ACTION TYPE

For substantiated complaints, a total of 46 actions were reported across 39 internal cases. Because a case may include more than one respondent and multiple complaints, more than one action may be associated with a single case. A total of 207 substantiated complaints were recorded in the DCTS. Of these 207 complaints, 46 actions were reported in 39 internal cases.
