Subject: Official State Holidays For The 1989-90 Fiscal Year


This is to advise you of the State holidays to be observed by State employees excluded from collective bargaining during the 1989-90 fiscal year. Employees shall be entitled to the following holidays:

Tuesday, July 4, 1989	Independence Day
Monday, September 4, 1989	Labor Day
Monday, October 9, 1989	Columbus Day
Friday, November 10, 1989	Veterans Day
Thursday, November 23, 1989	Thanksgiving Day
Friday, November 24, 1989	Day After Thanksgiving
Monday, December 25, 1989	Christmas Day
Monday, January 1, 1990	New Year's Day
Monday, January 15, 1990	Martin Luther King Jr. Day
Monday, February 12, 1990	Lincoln's Birthday
Monday, February 19, 1990	Washington's Birthday
Monday, May 28, 1990	Memorial Day

In addition to these holidays, there is one personal holiday, per fiscal year, for every nonrepresented employee upon completion of six months of his or her initial probationary period in State service. The personal holiday will be credited to eligible employees on the first day of July.

Holiday provisions for employees covered by bargaining agreements may be found in the appropriate Memoranda of Understanding for each bargaining unit.
