Financial concerns can create stress and worry, particularly for employees who are unsure of where to turn. The Employee Assistance Program (EAP) offers financial consulting services to assist employees and eligible family members with a wide spectrum of financial topics.

EAP offers online tools, resources, and up to a 60-minute telephone consultation with a financial counselor for issues such as budgeting, debt consolidation, loans, mortgage assistance, retirement, saving for college, IRS matters, and other financial concerns. Financial consultants have extensive experience advising individuals on how to take control of their finances and plan for the future.
