Side Letter Agreement – DJJ Closure Retention Incentive Pay Differential

As identified in the State's Notice to the California Correctional Officers Association (CPOA) dated February 9, 2022, the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation – Division of Juvenile Justice is implementing a Pay Differential (PD) to retain staff through June 30, 2023.

Discussions occurred between February 25, 2022 and March 7, 2022, and the parties agreed to implement the PD as drafted and the abolishment of PD 451. January 2022 through June 30, 2023, eligible CCPOA represented classifications at DJJ may receive up to \$45,000. in accordance with the PD.


