

STATEWIDE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CALIFORNIA CORRECTIONAL PEACE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION (CCPOA), THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH (CDPH), AND CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND REHABILITATION (CDCR), REGARDING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF PUBLIC HEALTH RESERVE CORPS PROGRAM (PHRC)


This Agreement represents the full and complete understanding reached by and between the parties at the conclusion of the Meet and Confer negotiations on May 23, 2022, regarding the implementation of Public Health Reserve Corps Program (PHRC) This Agreement becomes an addendum to the current State Bargaining Unit 6 Memorandum of Understanding, in effect from July 3, 2020, through July 2, 2023, Article 27, Section 27.01.

- The State and CCPOA agree Bargaining Unit 6 (BU 6) employees shall not be mandated to participate in the California Department of Public Health (CDPH), Public Health Reserve Corps (PHRC) Volunteer Program. However, if a BU 6 employee volunteers, the employee's application will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis and either approved or denied at the discretion of CDCR Management.
- In the event workload re-distribution concerns or disputes arise as a result of BU6 employees participating in the PHRC Volunteer Program, upon CCPOA's request a meeting will be scheduled with CDCR Chief of Labor to discuss.


