DIVISION OF ADULT INSTITUTIONS, INCARCERATED PERSONS ACCESS TO
INCONTINENCE RELATED SERVICES AND SUPPLIES, SW
(CDCR # 22-056-0/ CCPOA #71495)


This Agreement represents the full and complete understanding reached by and between the parties at the conclusion of the Meet and Confer negotiations on August 17, 2022, regarding the statewide implementation of the Incarcerated Persons Access to Incontinence Related Services and Supplies. This agreement becomes an addendum to the current State Bargaining Unit 6 (BU6) Memorandum of Understanding, Article 27, Section 27.01 which expires on July 2, 2023.

- The parties agree that within sixty (60) days of August 16, 2022, two (2) CCPOA local representatives will be provided up to eight (8) hours of Official Business (OB) each, to meet with local Management to discuss location of the secured supply site and the locally established supply par levels.
- The parties agree either party may request to reopen this table within sixty (60) days from October 16, 2022 to discuss unforeseen or newly identified issues that cannot be resolved locally.






