

AGREEMENT BETWEEN
CALIFORNIA CORRECTIONAL PEACE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION
AND THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND REHABILITATION (CDCR) CALIFORNIA
STATE PRISON, CORCORAN, REGARDING THE ACTIVATION OF THE HEALTH CARE FACILITY IMPROVEMENT
PROJECT, ENHANCED OUTPATIENT PROGRAM, ADMINISTRATIVE SEGREGATION UNIT CLINIC
(CDCR #22-101-0/NG #71887/CalHR #3929)

This Agreement represents the full and complete understanding reached by and between the parties at the conclusion of the Meet and Confer negotiations on February 28, 2023, regarding the activation of the HCFIP EOP ASU Clinic. This agreement becomes an addendum to the current State Bargaining Unit 6, Memorandum of Understanding, Article 27, Section 27.01 which expires on July 2, 2023.

- CCPOA and the State (COR) agree that for safety and security, utilizing existing funds, materials and resources, plexiglass and a locking food port will be attached on all free-standing holding cells in the EOP ASU Clinic prior to implementation.
- CCPOA and the State (COR) agree utilizing existing funds, materials and resources the EOP ASU Clinic Officer will have access to a work station which will be supplied with a computer and phone prior to implementation.
- CCPOA and the State (COR) agree that, with the exception of the Dental area in EOP ASU Clinic, existing funds, materials and resources will be utilized to provide the assigned clinic officers with the appropriate keys for entry and all treatment spaces prior to implementation.
- CCPOA and the State (COR) agree, when both GP and MAX custody patients are in the EOP ASU Clinic, BU6 staff will ensure patients will be staged appropriately for safety and security.
- CCPOA and the State (COR) agree that if any services other than Optometry and ISUDT initial consultations are added to the EOP ASU Clinic as an extension of the CTC during construction, the local Chapter will be notified within (14) fourteen days to engage in local discussions. If unable to resolve locally CCPOA may request to reopen the table within 14 days of the local meeting.
- CCPOA and the State (COR) agree that (30) days prior to activation of solely the EOP ASU Clinic, the local Chapter shall be notified to engage in local discussions regarding the impact created by activation. If unable to resolve locally CCPOA may request to reopen the table within 30 days of the local meeting.
- CCPOA and Corcoran Management agree that either party may request to reopen this table within ninety (90) days of activation of the EOP ASU Clinic to discuss unforeseen or newly identified issues that cannot be resolved locally.


