## AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CALIFORNIA CORRECTIONAL PEACE OFFICERS' ASSOCIATION (CCPOA) AND

THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA,

DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND REHABILITATION (CDCR), DIVISION OF REHABILITATIVE PROGRAMS (DRP), STATEWIDE IMPLEMENTATION OF LAPTOPS FOR STUDENTS ENROLLED IN REHABILITATIVE PROGRAMS

(CDCR LOG #21-050-0 CCPOA # 54623 and CalHR #3547)

This Agreement represents the full and complete understanding reached by and between the parties at the conclusion of the Meet and Confer negotiations, which concluded on March 23, 2023, regarding the Implementation of Laptops for Students Enrolled in Rehabilitative Programs. This Agreement becomes an Addendum to the current State Bargaining Unit 6 Memorandum of Understanding, Article 27, Section 27.01, which expires on July 2, 2023.

1. The State and CCPOA agree that BU6 staff are not responsible for the distribution of the laptops used for students in rehabilitative programs.

In the event of situations that may impose a security threat or incidents in which the educational laptops become contraband due to inappropriate use, BU6 staff shall confiscate the contraband and follow local institutional policies and procedures until such time Education can retrieve the confiscated laptops.
