This Agreement represents the full and complete understanding reached by and between the parties at the conclusion of the Meet and Confer negotiations on March 7, 2023, regarding the statewide California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR), Division of Adult Institutions (DAI), Implementation of the Expansion of the Opioid Overdose Program for Inmates and Staff. This agreement becomes an addendum to the current State Bargaining Unit 6 Memorandum of Understanding, Article 27, Section 27.01, which expires on July 2, 2023.

1. The parties agree that within thirty (30) calendar days prior to this implementation at each institution, up to two (2) local CCPOA representatives shall be provided up to eight (8) hours each of Official Business (OB) to conduct a local meet and discuss.

Topics of discussion may include, but are not limited to, the following:


- Locations where the Intranasal Naloxone (Narcan) will be stored and accessed at each institution.
2. The parties agree that the initial training for Correctional Officers will be instructor led and will commence at each institution prior to implementation, to be completed within ninety days from date of implementation.
  3. The parties agree that either party may request to reopen this table within ninety (90) days from the local meet and discuss, to address any unforeseen or newly identified BU 6 impact issues that cannot first be resolved locally.
