This agreement is an addendum to the current Bargaining Unit Six Memorandum of Understanding under Section 27.01 which expires on July 2, 2023.

- 1. The parties agree that within 45 days of this Agreement, two (2) CCPOA representatives will be released on Official Business, eight (8) hours each, in order to meet locally with the local management team to discuss the specific local applications of the I-Flex program. These discussions may include, but are not limited to:
 - Post Orders in I-Flex Unit(s)
 - Availability to I-Flex Ops
