AND THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND REHABILITATION (CDCR) CALIFORNIA STATE PRISON, CORCORAN, NOTICE REGARDING THE ACTIVATION OF THE HEALTH CARE FACILITY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, TREATMENT AND TRIAGE AREA BUILDING (CDCR LOG NO. 23-085-0) /NG #72264/Calhr #4057)

This Agreement represents the full and complete understanding reached by and between the parties at the conclusion of the Meet and Confer negotiations on October 19, 2023, regarding the activation of the Health Care Facility Improvement Project, Treatment and Triage Area Building. This agreement becomes an addendum to the current State Bargaining Unit 6, Memorandum of Understanding, Article 27, Section 27.01 which expires on July 2, 2025.

- For safety and security, CCPOA and CDCR (COR) agree that the outer entrance to the TTA will remain locked when not in use.
- CDCR (COR) agrees to ensure that all appropriate staff (i.e., assigned Correctional Treatment Center staff/Code Responders as determined by COR) have the key to the outer TTA door utilizing existing funds, materials, and resources.
- CCPOA and CDCR (COR) agree that the holding cells in the TTA will not routinely be used as staging for any other area. In the event of an unforeseen circumstance that would require the use of these holding cells, without delaying operations, management will subsequently notify the local Chapter President or designee.
