<b>CRITERIA</b>
When the duties of the Supervising Attorney involve responsibility for supervising, directing, controlling, and reviewing the work of a large subordinate attorney staff, the differential will be based on the following:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A Supervising Attorney with a subordinate staff of 6 to 11 attorneys shall receive a 5% differential.</li> <li>A Supervising Attorney with a subordinate staff of 12 or more attorneys shall receive a 10% differential.</li> <li>A Supervising Attorney with a subordinate staff of 3 to 5 attorneys is not eligible to receive a differential.</li> </ul>
