CRITERIA	
•	Special Agent and Special Agent Supervisor, Department of Justice, when designated and utilized by management in a training capacity to train new employees or retrain existing employees shall receive the differential for each pay period provided the designated Special Agent or Special Agent Supervisor is assigned a trainee on a daily basis, eight hours a day for 20 full work days or its equivalent.
•	A Special Agent or Special Agent Supervisor who receives this differential shall be involved in evaluating the job effectiveness of the trainee. Differential payments shall be made during the following pay period provided certification of eligibility occurs prior to the payroll cutoff date (i.e., preliminary attendance report). Certification occurring after the deadline date may result in a delayed payment to a following pay period.
•	Field Training Officer differential does not apply to situations where an experienced or skilled worker is required to informally impart his/her knowledge to a newly hired or less experienced employee.
