CRITERIA

- When a Firefighter assumes and is later approved or assigned to work in a lead capacity with immediate responsibility for fire or emergency services, the Firefighter will be paid two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50) per hour pay differential for all hours so assigned. The lead person assignment will be equitably distributed among eligible Firefighters. Only those Firefighters who have a minimum of three years service as a Firefighter, or the written approval of the Fires Chief shall be included on the rotational list.
- A Fire Chief shall be considered off duty at all times other than:
 - a. Their scheduled 40 duty hours per week (excluding holidays, vacation, or sick time), and;
 - b. When they are called out to supervise a fire scene or other incident within the jurisdiction of the fire department.
