CRITERIA

Service Employees International Union (SEIU), Local 1000, Bargaining Unit (BU) 7, and 18 Classifications:

- Effective July 1, 2020, the minimum salary in the salary range for all SEIU, Local 1000, Bargaining Unit (BU) 7, and 18 classifications shall be no less than \$15 (fifteen dollars) per hour.
- All employees in the SEIU, Local 1000, BU 7, and BU 18 classifications listed above who are subject to the Personal Leave Program 2020 (PLP 2020) are entitled to receive the equity adjustment percentage specified for the class effective July 1, 2020, regardless of the individual employee's actual rate of pay.
- Please refer to the Side Letters to the current Memorandum of Understanding between SEIU Local 1000, BU07, and BU18 and the State of California.

BU 12 Classifications:

- Effective January 1, 2021, the minimum salary in the salary range for all BU 12 classifications shall be no less than \$15 (fifteen dollars) per hour.
- All employees in the BU 12 classifications listed above who are subject to the PLP 2020 are entitled to receive the equity adjustment percentage specified for the class effective January 1, 2021, regardless of the individual employee's actual rate of pay.
- Please refer to the Side Letter to the current Memorandum of Understanding between BU 12 and the State of California.
