Subject: Fair Share Fee Election - Bargaining Unit 1

A secret ballot election shall be held under the supervision of the Public Employment Relations Board (PERB) among the employees of Bargaining Unit 1 (Administrative, Financial and Staff Services) to determine whether they desire fair share fees. This fair share fee election was included in the unit collective bargaining agreement that expires June 30, 1991.

On April 22, 1991 the PERB will mail a Notice of Election to the home address of each individual whose name appears on the list of eligible voters. The Notice shall contain a statement of the purpose of the fair share fee election, a copy of the fair share fee provision to be voted on, a summary of the fair share fee provision (including a description of current CSEA dues and fair share fee amounts), a sample ballot, and information regarding the ballot process.

On May 7, 1991, the PERB will mail a ballot to the home address of each individual whose name appears on the list of eligible voters, using first class mail.

Ballots must be returned to the PERB no later than 12:00 noon, Thursday, May 30, 1991, and will be counted by the PERB, in accordance with its procedures, on Tuesday, June 4, 1991.
