
Subject: 1991/92 Budget

As you are aware, the 1991/92 Budget has not yet been approved. When the budget is delayed, questions arise regarding the employment and compensation status of employees.

There is no change in employee status. Government Code sections 1231, 1231.1, and 1231.2 assure the continuity of State operations during a "no budget" period. These statutes:

1. Assure the status and the continuity of employment of current employees and new employees hired during the "no budget" period will not change because of the failure to enact a budget.
2. Guarantee payment of salaries as if the budget had been adopted on or prior to July 1, 1991. (However, release of pay warrants may be delayed pending approval of the budget.)
3. Guarantee payment of obligations authorized by the budget and incurred between the commencement of the fiscal year and effective date of the budget.
