

As described in PML 2001-005, State employees shall receive a Holiday credit for the day unless otherwise provided in their collective bargaining agreement.

School children throughout California will honor Cesar Chavez by observing Cesar Chavez Day on Friday, March 30, 2001, as a Day of Service and Learning. The bookmark being distributed with the February paychecks serves as a reminder to State employees with school-age children that although the holiday officially falls on Saturday, March 31, school children are encouraged to participate in their school's special activities on March 30.
