General

The State recognizes that the California Association of Psychiatric Technicians contract expires July 1, 2022 and is prepared to negotiate any and all provisions of such contract for inclusion in a successor agreement. Further, the State will consider any issue that is within scope for inclusion in a successor contract. Specifically, the State is willing to meet and confer in good faith with the union on the following subjects:
