General

The employer recognizes that the California Association of Psychiatric Technicians contract expires July 1, 2016 and is prepared to negotiate any and all provisions of such contract for inclusion in a successor agreement. Further, the employer will consider any issue that is within scope for inclusion in a successor contract. Specifically, the State is willing to meet and confer in good faith with the union on the following subjects:

The State will be prepared to discuss health benefit plan design changes, health vesting and Other Post-Employment Benefits (OPEB). In addition, the State will be prepared to discuss changes to this article that are fiscally responsible and will achieve improved efficiencies within State government
