Additionally, if you are not currently enrolled in a health, dental or vision plan through COBRA, please complete the enclosed Dental Plan Enrollment Authorization (STD 692) Basic Vision Enrollment Authorization (STD 700), Premier Vision Enrollment Authorization (CalHR 774) and/or Health Benefits Plan Enrollment Form (HBD 12). If you are currently enrolled in COBRA coverage, you are still required to pay 102 percent of the premium (full premium amount plus a two-percent administration fee) until such time as you are approved for the subsidy.
